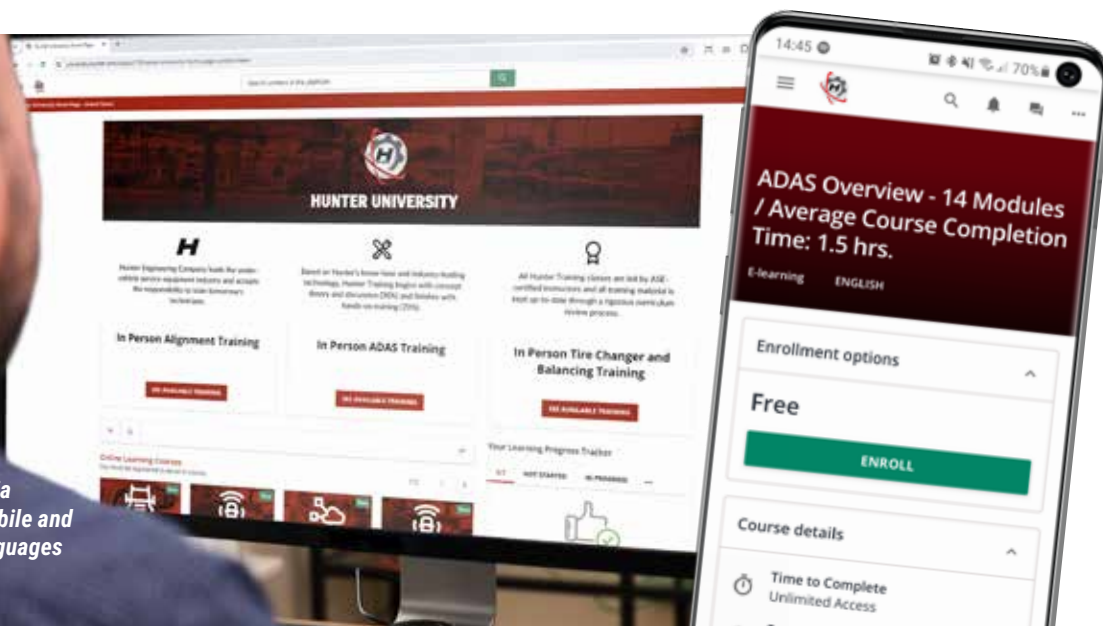

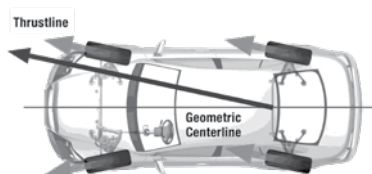

Introduction to Advanced Driver Assist Systems (ADAS)

Two-day (16 hours) class designed for the new or less experienced Vehicle Service Associate with a desire to learn the fundamentals of Advanced Drive Assistance Systems (ADAS) as it relates to post-wheel alignment procedures, including proper procedures for calibrating forward facing ADAS systems such as Lane Departure Warning systems (LDW) and/or Adaptive Cruise Control systems (ACC).

This course will also provide an overview of procedures required for calibrating lesser systems such as blind spot monitor, surround view, and rearview camera systems. Actual type and number of ADAS calibrations will vary from class to class.
